

CURE International (www.cure.org) is in need of a board certified pediatric orthopedic surgeon to provide coverage at their hospital's in San Pedro Sula, Honduras, Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, and Kijabe Kenya. Volunteer surgeons are needed throughout the year to help provide coverage while staff surgeons are on annual leave. Two week coverage is preferred; however the hospitals are willing to accept surgeons who are only available for a week.

CURE's hospitals treat a variety of pediatric limb deformities, fractures, scoliosis and other general orthopedic conditions. CURE hospitals also often have private adult patients as well, however this is CURE's our primary focus. It is generally not necessary to bring orthopedic instruments or supplies as our operating rooms and surgical areas are well-equipped – we do accept donations of specific items and this can be discussed on an individual basis as requested. Foreign language skills are not required as CURE will provide a medical translator to assist during clinics and in the OR if necessary.

CURE International will assist any interested volunteers in booking flights, arranging accommodations and in country transportation. All volunteers are asked to cover the cost of their flight, as well as in country accommodations and meals.
