

POSNA Video Theater: Recommended Surgical Technique Video Structure

1. Title Slide (required)

- a. Must be included as the 1st slide of the video, minimum display time of 3 seconds
- b. Include title of submission and complete author listing
- c. Institutional logos are only permitted on the title slide.

2. Disclosure Slide (required)

- a. Must be included as the 2nd slide of the video, minimum display time of 3 seconds
- b. **Commercial support and other relevant conflicts** must be disclosed. Submissions that appear as advertising will not be accepted. A partial list of relevant conflicts includes:
 1. Source of video funding
 2. Royalties
 3. Stock options
 4. Consulting income
 5. Research, educational, or other support
- c. **Off-Label Use**
 - i. Off-label use of medications, implants, or devices must be adequately disclosed on the Disclosure Slide and within the video

3. Introduction

- a. Etiology of the pathologic condition / mechanism of Injury
- b. Description of preoperative evaluation
 - i. Patient selection, indications, and contraindications
 - ii. Physical exam findings
 - iii. Preoperative testing and/or imaging (X-ray, CT, MRI)

4. Operative procedure

- a. Pre-procedure
 - i. Room setup and patient positioning
 - ii. Anesthesia recommendations
 - iii. Instrumentation and implants available
- b. Procedure
 - i. Exposure
 1. Describe surface anatomy & landmarks
 2. Describe structures at risk during exposure and procedure
 - ii. Incorporate images as part of description of procedure
 1. Fluoroscopic images / navigation
 2. Diagrams or models if the anatomy cannot be adequately visualized
 - iii. Describe intraoperative options during the procedure
 1. Rationale for procedural steps, fixation techniques and options
 - iv. Final intraoperative or early postop images as appropriate
 1. Clinical, fluoroscopy, X-ray, and/or CT/MRI
- c. Postoperative
 - i. Describe postoperative care and rehabilitation protocol
 - ii. Provide adequate follow-up of illustrated case
 1. Include clinical photos, gait video, X-rays, etc.

5. Conclusion

- a. Operative pearls and outcomes of the technique/procedure
- b. Potential complications and tips to avoid complications

6. Reference slide (required)

- a. Must be included as 2nd to last slide, minimum display time of 3 seconds
- b. Include relevant references with AMA style

7. Credit slide (required)

- a. Must be included as the final slide, minimum display time of 3 seconds
- b. Acknowledgements
- c. Description of copyright permission for images or animation/video segments within the submission
- d. Indicate if there are no acknowledgements and/or copyright permissions needed
