Registration/Payments:

Will there be a live meeting?

POSNA is planning a live, in person meeting with limited capacity in compliance with current COVID restrictions in Dallas, TX. We will continue to monitor the situation and make adjustments as city guidelines evolve.

When is the registration deadline for the Live Meeting?

Registration closes Friday, April 30, 2021. After this date, you will be required to register on-site (additional fees may apply)

Do I need to select the sessions I want to attend in advance?

Yes, it is important you select all the sessions you plan to attend during the registration process. This will help POSNA staff plan accordingly for socially distanced seating.

What is the cancellation policy?

A full refund will be granted if notification is received, in writing to posna@posna.org by Thursday, April 22, 2021. A 20% administrative fee will be applied after April 22, 2021. No refunds will be given after May 11, 2021.
