

GETTING TO DALLAS

With two major airports providing daily direct flights from more than 240 destinations, Dallas is four hours by air from almost anywhere in the country. Plus, the robust number of non-stop flights originating in Dallas offers travelers options and convenience.



DALLAS/FORT WORTH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (DFW)

FAST FACTS

- 20 miles to Downtown Dallas
- Service to 187 domestic and 62 international destinations
- 1,850 flights a day
- 69 million passengers each year
- 70+ dining options, including Dallas area favorites like Shinsei, Dallas Cowboys Club and Twisted Root Burger Co.
- Three airport hotels
- Minute Suites Nap Center features ten spacious private suites and hot showers

DEVELOPMENT

DFW Airport is currently upgrading its four original terminals with a \$2.7 billion Terminal Renewal and Improvement Program (TRIP) and is expected to be completed in 2020. The airport is also planning for Terminal F, a sixth terminal that could open as early as 2025 and bring up to 24 new gates.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION | DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART)

- Light rail to Downtown Dallas: approximately one hour
- Cost: \$3/single-ride pass, \$6/day pass
- Operating 4 - 1 a.m. daily

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- Approximate taxi cost to Downtown Dallas: \$40
- Approximate shuttle cost to Downtown Dallas: \$19 per person

- 23 carriers for domestic and international service

FAST FACTS

- Seven miles to Downtown Dallas
- 50+ non-stop destinations
- 600 flights a day
- 16 million passengers each year
- 20 dining options, including Sky Canyon by Celebrity Chef Stephan Pyles
- Love Field Conference Center located at the airport

DEVELOPMENT

In 2014, the airport underwent a \$519 million renovation, which opened 20 new gates, expanded the main lobby and baggage claim areas, opened a new ticketing/check-in hall and doubled the number of airport concessionaires. In 2018, the airport opened its third parking garage.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION | DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART)

- DART's Love Link 524 operates between Dallas Love Field and Inwood/Love Field Station, providing an airport connection to the DART Green Line and Orange Line.
- Light rail to Downtown Dallas: less than 15 minutes
- Cost: \$3/single-ride pass, \$6/day pass
- Operating 4 - 1 a.m. daily

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- Approximate taxi cost to Downtown Dallas: \$18
- Approximate shuttle cost to Downtown Dallas: \$19 per person
